Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc, £ 49.65  
La Tiare du Pape, Maison Bouachon, France, 2007  
*Flattering and complex nose based on fresh pepper, fresh summer fruits, lime and exotic fruits completed with notes of butter and vanilla. On the palate, the wine is full and lively.*

Pouilly Fumé, Ladoucette, £ 46.65  
Château de Nozet, France, 2004/05  
*From a famous Château of almost fairy-tale beauty in the village of Pouilly Fumé. A splendid deep gooseberry flavoured wine, with crisp, steely backbone. One of the finest wines from the Loire Valley.*

## Les Vins Rouges Classics

Chateau Cissac, Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Médoc, £ 46.65  
Domaine Vailard, Bordeaux, France, 2000  
*A deep red coloured wine with complex aromas of dark forest fruits including black cherry, plum and oak. Great finesse of tannins it has balanced acidity, integrated oak and a long finish.*

Givry, Cote Chalonnaise, Louis Latour, Burgundy, £ 33.65  
France, 2007  
*The best négociant offering Givry is Maison Louis Latour, whose wine exhibits an attractive earthy, spicy character. It has a rich fruit driven bouquet with notes of wild cherry and raspberry that ends on a smooth fruity note.*

Cote Rotie, Michel Ogier, Rhone, France, 2005 £ 49.65  
*This wine is a blend from some of the top vineyards on the Cote Blonde and Cote Brune hillsides and these terroirs harmonize the wine showing power, finesse, and complexity. A strong, well-balanced mouth with presence of silky tannins. Well structured and generous, the finish develops into notes of red plum. Excellent.*
